**Au Gres Sims Whitney Fire and Rescue Authority Proposal**

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the Township of Au Gres, Township of Sims, Township of Whitney, and the City of Au Gres, imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution be increased for said municipalities, by One (1) mill, being \$1.00 (One Dollar) per \$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollars) of the taxable value, for a period of Eight (8) years, 2026 to 2033 inclusive, on all real and personal property within the Au Gres Sims Whitney Fire and Rescue Authority, being the Township of Au Gres, Township of Sims, Township of Whitney, and the City of Au Gres for the purpose of operating the fire department equipment acquisitions and capital improvements?
