Description
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of Wright's Addition to the Village of Twining is described as follows: A parcel of land in the Southwest quarter of the southwest one quarter, Sec. 19, Turner Township, Arenac County and is bounded as follows: Commencing at a point which is South 87° 10' East 317.6 Ft. North 334 Ft. from the West corner common to Sections 19 and 20 Town 20 North, Range 6 East, thence South 157° 10' East 317.6 Ft.; thence North 100 East 247.5 Ft.; thence South 89° 10' East 100 Ft.; thence North 82° 00' West 349 Ft.; thence South 28° 20' West 882 Ft. to place of Beginning.

The bearings of lines as recorded on this are based on magnetic bearing of compass needle and transit angles.

All dimensions are in feet or decimals thereof.
 I HEREBY CERTIFY that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent monuments consisting of one inch or one and one-quarter inch gas pipe at least two feet long are planted at points marked thus O as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted and at all intersections of streets.

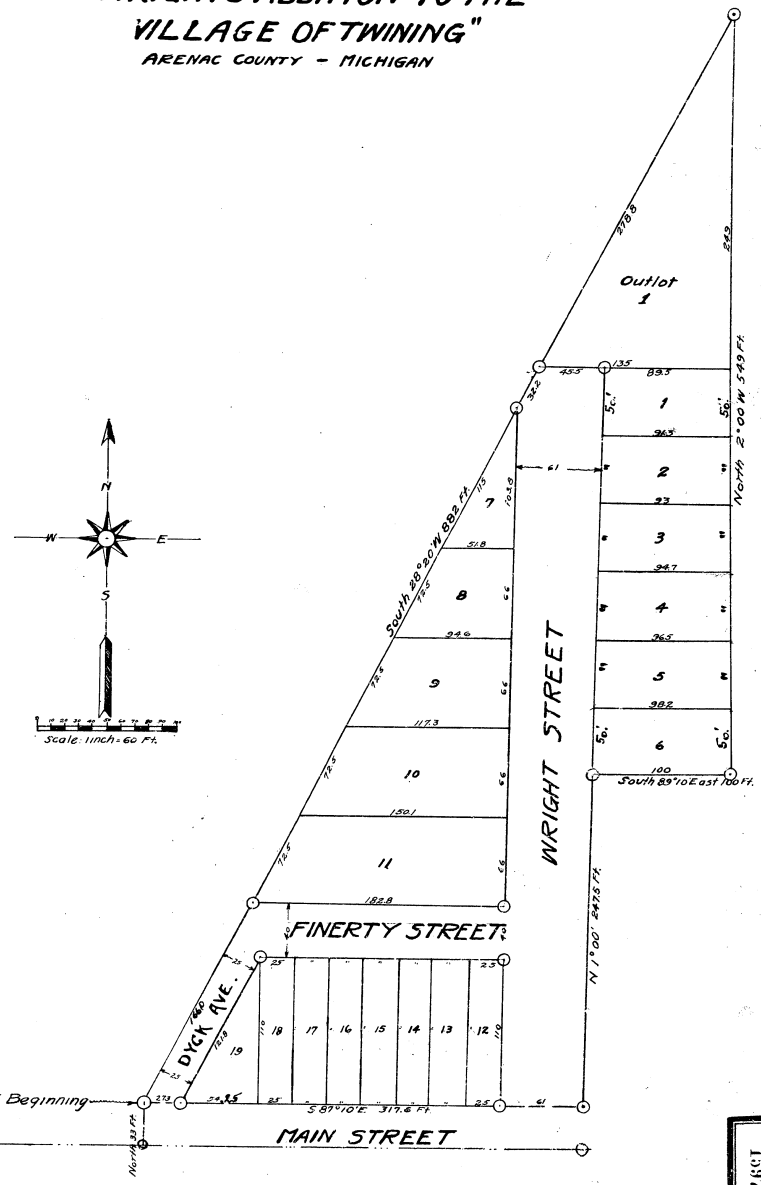

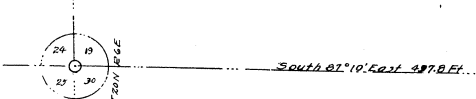
"WRIGHT'S ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF TWINING"
