**MSU Annual Report** – Julie Darnton presented the MSU Annual Report. Discussion on programs, increase in participants and positive economic impact in Arenac County.

**Prosecuting Attorney – Victim Advocate Position** – Mr. Broughton presented a letter for board review pertaining to the vacant position of Victim Advocate.
