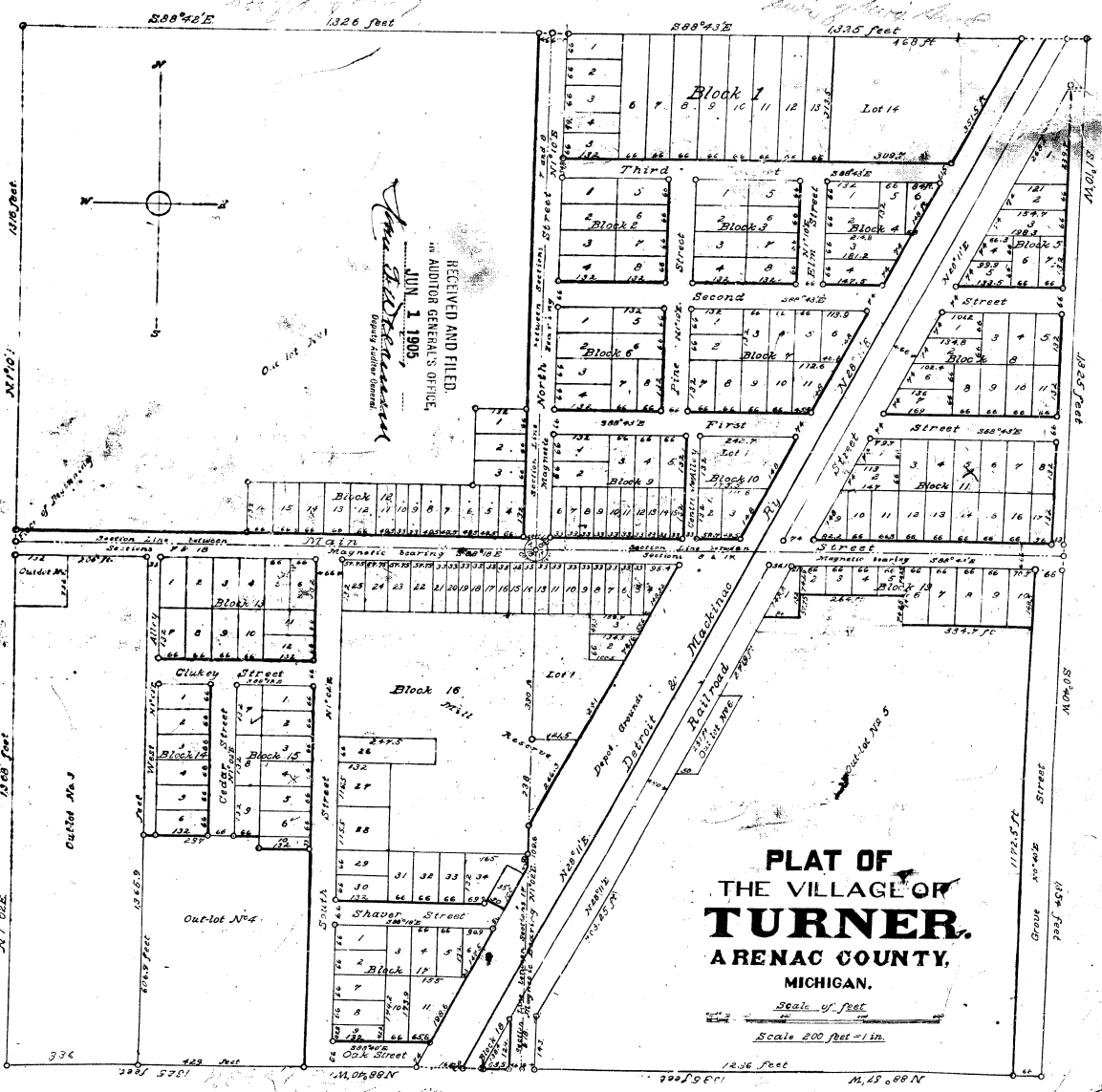
DESCRIPTION
