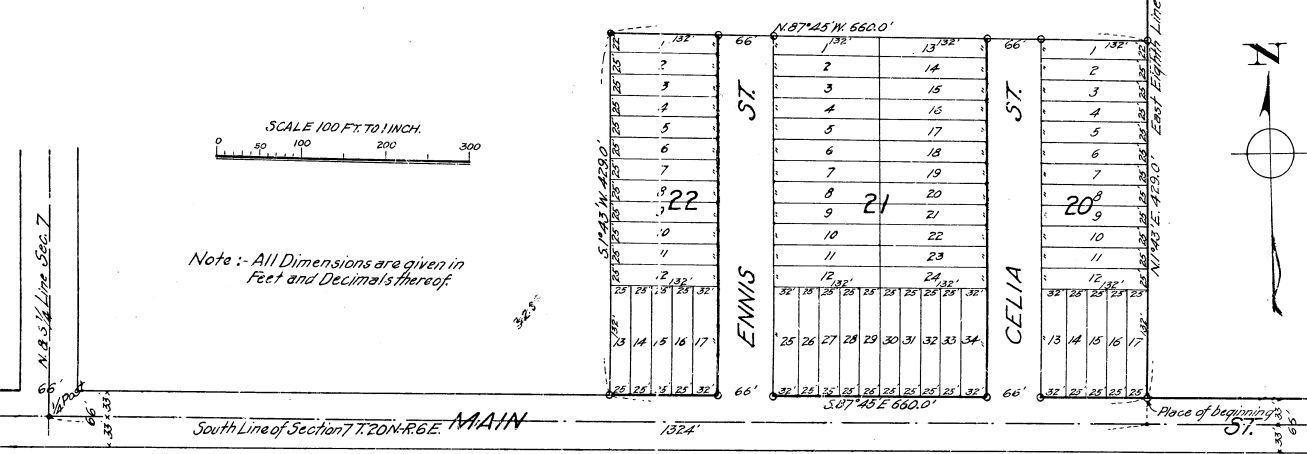

**DESCRIPTION**  
The land embraced in the annexed plat of Ennis Addition to the Village of Turner T.20N-R.6E. Arenac County Mich. is described as follows: Commencing at a point 33 feet northerly of the intersection of the East Eighth Line with the South Line of Section 7, T.20 N-R.6E which latter point is 1526 feet east from the 1/4 post of said Section 7 and running thence N1°43'E 429.0 feet along said East Eighth Line; thence N87°45'W parallel to said Section Line 660.0 feet; thence S1°43'W parallel to said Eighth Line 429.0 feet to a point 33 feet northerly from said Section Line; thence S87°45'E parallel to said Section Line 660.0 feet to the place of beginning.
