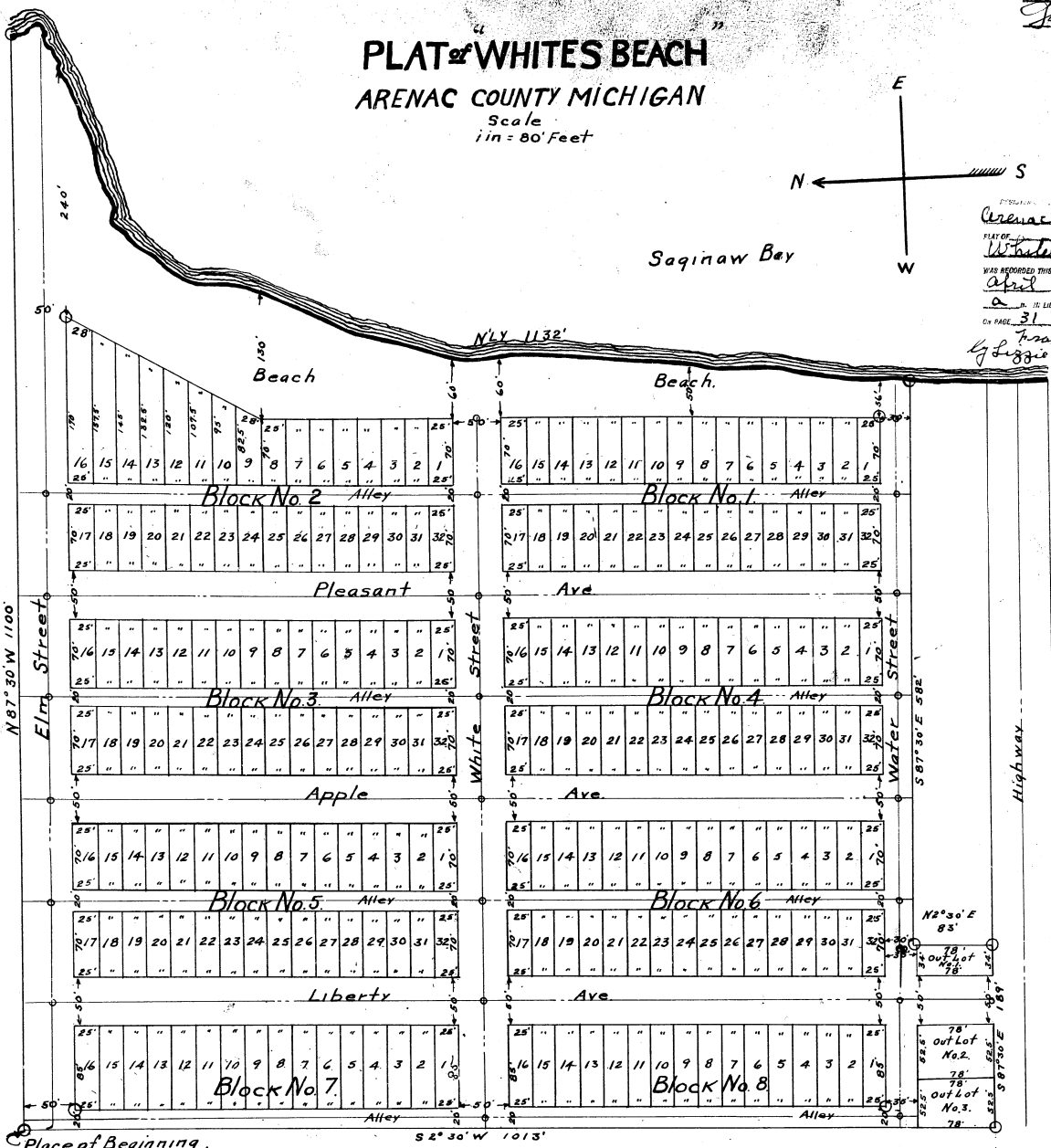
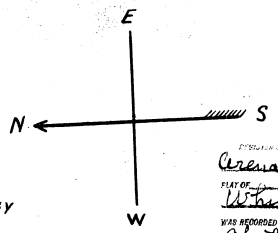

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Whites Beach Arenac County, Mich is described as follows: Commencing at the NE corner of sec. 29, T18N R 5E running thence N 89° 30' E 710'; thence S 2° 30' W 323.4' to place of starting, Running thence S 2° 30' W 1013'; thence S 87° 30' E 189'; thence N 2° 30' E 83'; thence S 87° 30' E 582' to shore line of Saginaw Bay, thence Northerly along shore line 1132' to North boundary line of this plat; thence N 87° 30' W 1100' to place of beginning
