      - 1. Letter to be sent with Exhibits showing encroachment and photos of encroachment to conduct meeting.

- 3. Easements Branch of Dobson Drain
  - a. Easement dimensions
    - i. Existing TOB to TOB -22 ft (+/-)
    - ii. Minimum Recommended Easement Width for Standard Drain Maintenance 50 ft Discussed sending easement letters out with 80 ft total width. 20/60.
  - b. Alternatives
    - i. Reroute ditch to the south along Airpark Road extension
    - ii. Tabled until hydraulic analysis is complete
- 4. Design
  - a. Hydrology and Hydraulics
    - i. Existing Conditions Review of Flooding Extents
      - 1. March 2<sup>nd</sup> through March 3<sup>rd</sup> Event relates closely to a 500yr24hr Design Storm based on high water marks provided by landowners.
      - Observed Flooding
        - a. 10yr24hr Design Storm
          - i. Flooding within floodplain of the Middle Branch of the Pine River
    - ii. Gary Bilacic Crossing Analysis (N East City Limits Road)
      - 1. 0.03 ft in Hydraulic Grade Reduction from removal of culvert Ralph Pestrue indicated that the crossing has failed and filled with material.
